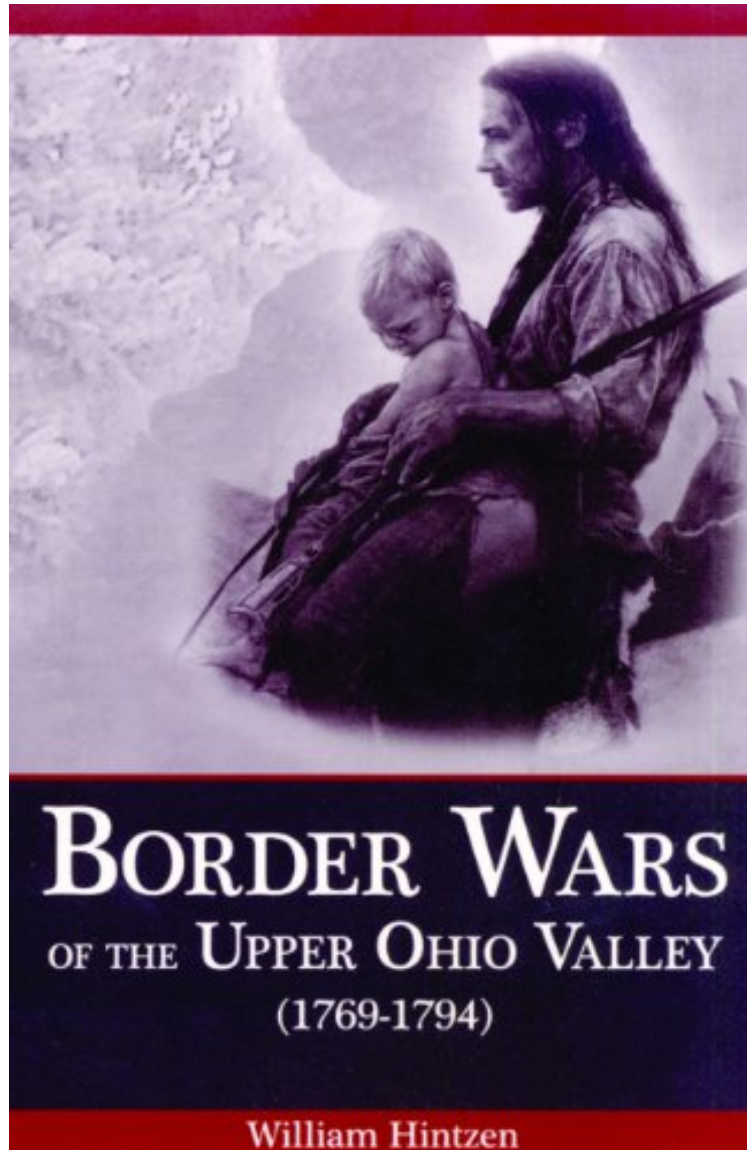

There is so much we don't know about this period even though many have written about it. This is a well written and researched book and should be part of any collection of works dealing with the sweeping changes after the French and Indian wars. I would not call it

exhaustive by any criteria because there are broader cultural issues on a global scale that are part of the dynamics but would mostly distract from this treatment of the raw and very dangerous lives of those who acted on those circumstances for their own personal motives.
