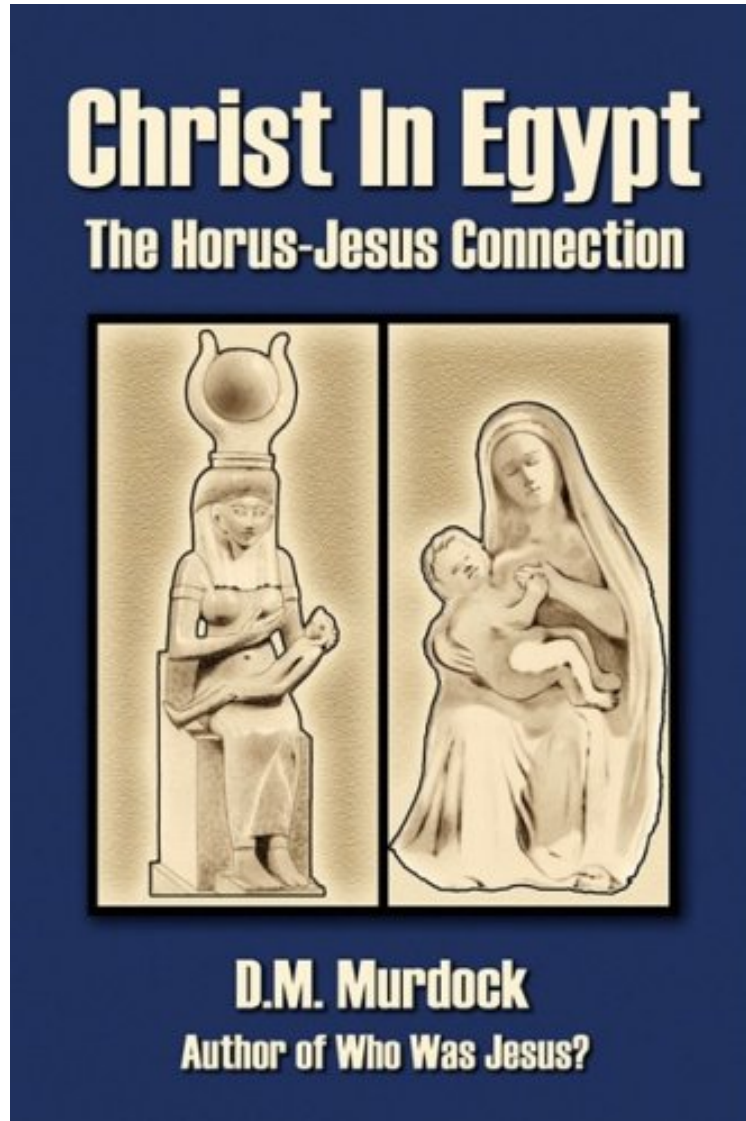

However one shouldn't stop there since the whole book is a treasure trove of academically relevant explanations and citations practically on every page. Contrary to what some people claim, D.M. Murdock - may she R.I.P. - was more a compiler of mainstream Egyptologists and related scholars than an author, although throughout the book she does give an accompanying well supported opinion based on what the many scholars she cites conclude.
