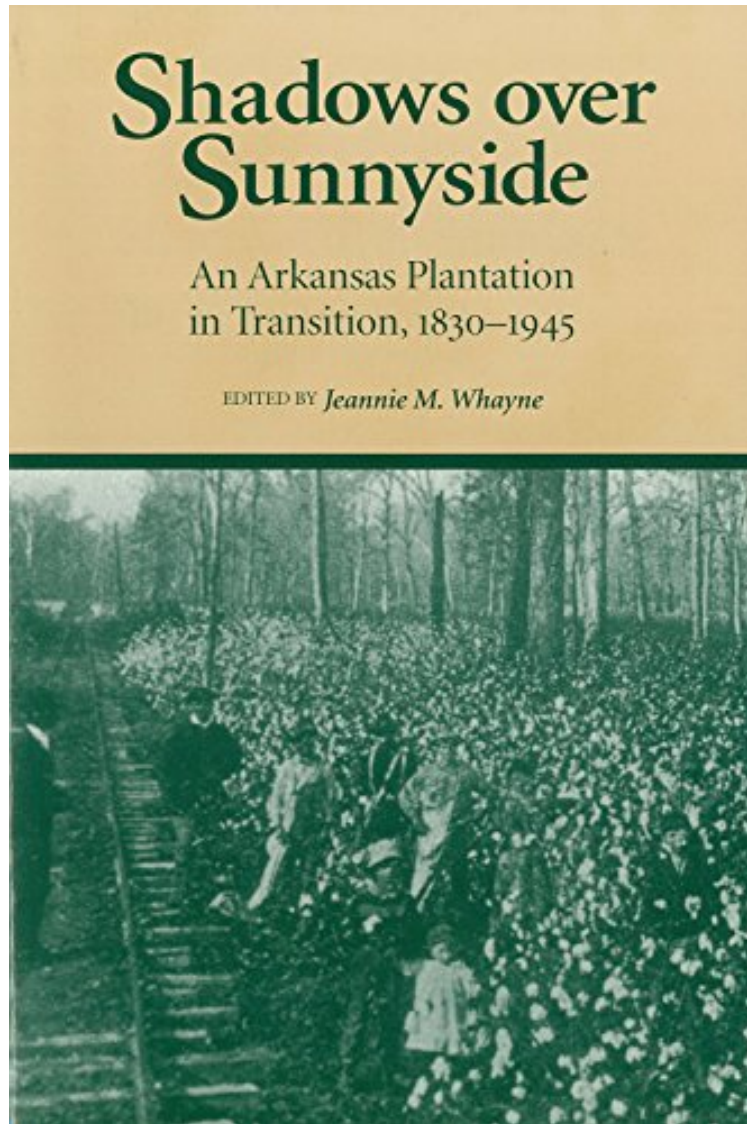


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# Shadows over Sunnyside : An Arkansas Plantation in Transition, 1830-1945
